### **5th Grade:**

The Indian in the Cupboard by Lynne Reid Banks

The One and Only Ivan by Katherine Applegate

### **6th/7th/8th Grade: (Choose two titles)**

Choose any novel that is a Newbery Medal or Newbery Honor books **and** more than 150 pages. The Newbery award is a literature award for children from the American Library Association. Parents are able to help make a choice about what books they want their students to read because there is a possibility that the list contains books that some parents might have issues with, but all of them have been specifically chosen as children's literature.
