



## K-5 Textual Literacy

### First Grade

By the end of First Grade, students will:

- Comprehend storyline and main mitzvot of Parshat Hashavua (weekly Torah portion)
- Comprehend age-appropriate written sentences and stories

### Second Grade

By the end of Second Grade, students will:

- Learn two parshas (chapters), Lech Lecha and Vayera
- Read Pesukim (sentences) directly from the Chumash
- Identify prefixes, suffixes, and frequently used shorashim and sight words
- Use Gematria (numerical values) to find the Parsha, Perek and Pasuk
- Comprehend the narrative and follows the storyline of Chumash sections studied
- Apply texts and skills to everyday life experiences
- Use L'havin U'Lehaskil workbooks to practice skills

### Third Grade

By the end of Third Grade, students will:

- Read Pesukim (sentences) with correct pauses based on punctuation
- Translate, decode, and comprehend pesukim
- Define Shorashim (root words) and Milim (words) appropriate for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
- Read Rashi script

### Fourth Grade

By the end of Fourth Grade, students will:

- Summarize story of Yehoshua (Joshua)
- Independently read, translate and comprehend pesukim
- Read Rashi; understand how he helps explain Passuk

## **Fifth Grade**

By the end of Fifth Grade, students will:

- Independently translate and understand pesukim
- Identify and understand Rashi's question and answer
- Collaborate with learning partners to deepen understanding of Pesukim
- Read, translate and understand the concepts of the Mishna
- Follow narrative for Shoftim (Navi)
