NEW Tuition Model

In our ongoing effort to address day school affordability, San Diego Hebrew Day has decided to modify the tuition structure as follows:

Tuition Deposit

Prior to February 1st, 2020 a non-refundable tuition deposit of \$500 per student is due with the admission application(s). Receipt of this deposit will secure your child(ren)'s spot and will apply to your tuition bill. After February 1st, 2020 the required deposit increases to \$700.

Base Tuition

All Grades, Infant thru 8	\$15,000
Preschool, 5 half days	\$10,000
Preschool, 3 half days	\$8,000

School Development and Scholarship Fund Donation

A per-student contribution to Hebrew Day's new School Development and Scholarship fund will ensure fiscal stability and facility enhancement while continuing to provide quality education to families in need of financial assistance.

This tax-deductible per-student donation will continue to strengthen our educational offering while affording Hebrew Day the ability to competitively reduce the average tuition.

Preschool:	\$500
Elementary School:	\$4,000
Middle School:	\$5,000

Security

Security fee per family: \$300

Working Family Flexibility (optional)

For working families and those who need drop off/pick up flexibility, Hebrew Day will continue to offer its after-care program in addition to introducing a before-care program (This program will be offered depending on current pandemic conditions and County mandates/regulations).

Before-care:	7:30AM-8:00AM
After-care:	3:30PM-5:30PM M-Th / 2:00PM-4:00PM Fri
Fee:	\$2,000 per student per year or \$30/day

Discounts

Continuing the theme to address affordability, the following generous discounts are available:

Sibling: Families enrolling 2 or more students will receive a 5% discount on Base Tuition
This discount may be combined with the following discount(s): Pre-Paid

Pre-Paid: Families paying their full Base Tuition bill prior to the following dates will receive a discount on their Base Tuition as follows: prior to February 15, 2020: 7% discount; prior to April 15, 2020: 6% discount; prior to Jun 15, 2020: 5% discount; prior to Aug 15, 2020: 4% discount
This discount may be combined with the following discount(s): Sibling, Employee, New Family

Employee or Jewish Community Employee: Hebrew Day employees or families with one or both parents employed full time in a Jewish community non-profit institution will receive a 20% discount on Base Tuition
This discount may be combined with the following discount(s): Pre-Paid

New Family: Families who are new to the Hebrew Day community will receive a 40% discount on Base Tuition for their first year and 20% for their second year.
This discount may be combined with the following discount(s): Pre-Paid

Tuition Payment Options for 2021 - 22

Tuition will be billed in March 2021 for the full 2021-22 school year. First tuition payment is due, with the signed contract, within two weeks of the family receiving their contract. Remaining payment in full, or monthly payments, will begin in June 2021.

Tuition Payment Options

Families may choose to pay tuition in one of three ways:

- In Full:
See previous page for paid-in full discounts.
- Monthly Payments Through FACTS:
Tuition can be paid monthly, beginning in June 2021, in either 10 or 12 monthly payments, debited from a specified checking or savings accounts through the FACTS Tuition Payment Plan. FACTS charges a \$45 per year, per family, charge for using their service. Families who choose to pay tuition through FACTS must also provide SDHD with a current credit card number.
- Monthly Payments with a Credit Card:
Tuition can be paid monthly, beginning in June 2021, in either 10 or 12 monthly payments, charged from a specified credit card that the family provides to the SDHD Business office. All payments made by credit card will incur an additional 3.5% convenience fee.

Tuition Policies

Enrollment for the school year may be cancelled by submitting a written cancellation notice prior to June 1, 2021. The initial tuition deposit of \$700, submitted with the Application for Admission, is non-refundable. However, the first tuition payment, made with the return of the signed contract, is refundable, if a written cancellation notice is submitted to SDHD by June 1, 2021. If enrollment is canceled after June 1, 2021, the family is obligated to pay the 2020-21 tuition in full.

Each student's enrollment at SDHD is contingent upon prompt payment of tuition. If tuition payments are delinquent, the student may be removed from classes and/or dismissed from the school.
