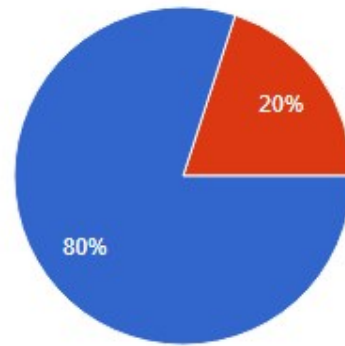


If San Diego is still on the state monitored list, but Hebrew Day K-5 is granted a waiver to allow for the safe reopening of our campus:
