Hebrew Day Travel Policy (Updated 6/23/2021)

All travel, even that of a household member, must be reported on our travel plans form. We are asking all families to confirm travel plans outside of California, so that we can better plan for in-person attendance.

Unvaccinated (including only partially vaccinated)

Domestic or international travel:

- May return to school after 7-day quarantine with a negative test (done 3-5 days after returning from travel), or after 10-day quarantine if no test is done
- Complete mandatory travel form by <u>clicking here</u>.

Fully vaccinated***

Domestic travel:

No testing or quarantine required (as long as there are no COVID symptoms)

International travel:

- No quarantine required (as long as there are no COVID symptoms)
- Need to have a negative test done 3-5 days after returning from travel
- Complete mandatory travel form by clicking here.

(***Fully vaccinated means you are 2 weeks after your 2nd dose of Moderna/Pfizer vaccine, or 2 weeks after 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine)

Please be aware that the CDC recommends delaying travel until fully vaccinated (particularly if traveling internationally), and taking precautions around large numbers of people indoors and when taking public transit. Some countries are still experiencing high COVID case rates, and there are several concerning COVID variants circulating around the world. In addition, there may be additional testing requirements prior to your departure and arrival back home depending on your destination.
